The petitioner was granted regular bail in FIR No.103 dated 11.8.2017 registered at Police Station, Bilga, District Jalandhar, under Section 21 of the Narcotic Drugs and Psychotropic Substances Act, 1985. It is submitted that he was appearing in the trial on every date but on 24.5.2018, he could not appear as his counsel had informed him a wrong date. Thus, the bail bonds of the petitioner have been cancelled and non-bailable warrants of arrest have been issued.

Learned counsel for the petitioner submits that the petitioner is willing to join the trial and undertakes not to absent himself again.

Notice of motion.

Mr. Kirat Singh Sidhu, learned DAG, Punjab, accepts notice. Let two copies of the complete paper book be supplied to him during the course of day.

The petition is disposed of with a direction to the petitioner to surrender before the trial Court on or before 22.2.2019 and seek regular bail. In case, such an

application is filed, the trial Court is directed to allow the same. It is further made clear that in case of even a single default in future, the petitioner shall deprive himself of bail till the conclusion of trial.
