Present petition under Section 438 of the Criminal Procedure Code has been filed for grant of anticipatory bail to the petitioner in Complaint Case No.12 of 04.03.2009, titled as 'Bahadur Singh vs. Balwinder Singh and others', wherein vide order dated 29.01.2013 passed by learned Judicial Magistrate Ist Class, Malerkotla, the petitioner has been summoned to face trial under Sections 420, 427, 500, 506, 148 and 149 of the Indian Penal Code.

Learned counsel representing the petitioner contended that the petitioner herein is an accused in aforementioned complaint and the main dispute between the parties has been settled amicably. The petitioner is ready to appear before the Court and make statement in terms of the compromise for compounding of the offence.

Memo of appearance filed on behalf of respondent No.2(a) and 2(b) is taken on record.

Learned counsel representing respondent No.2(a) and 2(b) affirmed the fact that the matter has been settled amicably between the parties.

In view of the above, the present petition is accepted. In case the petitioner appears before learned trial Judge within a period of two weeks from today and moves an application for bail, he shall be admitted to bail on his furnishing adequate bail bond and surety bond to the satisfaction of learned trial Judge and thereafter, the parties shall make statements before the Court for compounding of the offence in terms of the compromise.
