The present petition has been filed under Section 438 Code of Criminal Procedure for grant of anticipatory bail to the petitioner in case FIR No.115 dated 30.8.2015 registered for the offences punishable under Sections 354-B, 120-B of Indian Penal Code, at Police Station Division No.2, Pathankot, District Gurdaspur.

Heard.

It has been submitted that the petitioner is a poor person and is unable to pay this amount.

Serious allegations have been levelled against the petitioner that on 29.8.2015 at about 10:00 p.m., the prosecutrix and her husband were having a stall on the railway line. In the meanwhile, the petitioner appeared there and he hurled filthy words and gone committing eve teasing with the prosecutrix. When her husband intervened, he also had an altercation with him. Thereafter, the petitioner caught hold the prosecutrix and torn all her

clothes. The petitioner has committed all this on a public place and in the presence of the husband of the prosecutrix.

To the mind of this Court, the petitioner is not entitled to the concession of pre-arrest bail.

Dismissed.
