The learned counsel contends that the property purchased by the petitioner had been trespassed by respondent No.6 Kanwaljit Singh, regarding which he had made a representation/complaint (Annexure P-4) to the police but no action has been taken thereupon.

Having heard the learned counsel for the petitioner, the petition is disposed of with a direction to respondent No.3-Commissioner of Police, Amritsar to look into the matter and to dispose of the representations (Annexures P-4 and P-5), expeditiously, in accordance with law. In case the allegations levelled therein are found to be well founded then necessary steps be taken thereupon as warranted under law at the earliest.

A copy of this order alongwith representations (Annexures P-4 and P-5) be sent to respondent No.3-Commissioner of Police, Amritsar so as to enable him to do the needful expeditiously.
