The petitioner has preferred the instant petition under Section 438 Cr.P.C., for grant of pre-arrest bail in case FIR No.06 dated 14.01.2019, registered under Sections 354, 451, 323, 509 IPC, at Police Station Sadar Sangrur, District Sangrur.

Learned counsel for the petitioner has been submitted that the compromise has been effected between the parties.

Learned State counsel has stated that the petitioner has joined the investigation; nothing is to be recovered from him and he is no more required for custodial interrogation.

In the circumstances, without going into the merits of the case, I do not deem it appropriate to deny the concession of anticipatory bail to the petitioner in the present case.

Resultantly, the interim order dated 20.02.2019 is made absolute subject to the conditions as envisaged under Section 438(2) Cr.P.C.

Petition stands allowed.
