Learned counsel for the petitioner states that the retiral benefits have been released to the petitioner, however, the family pension has not been given.

Learned counsel for the respondents states that the succession certificate was produced only qua the retiral benefits and not for the family pension. He further submits that no cause of action survives for pursuing the contempt petition as there is no disobedience of the order of this Court much less to say wilfull disobedience.

At this stage, learned counsel for the petitioner states that if the amount of family pension is disclosed, the petitioner will apply for the succession certificate and produce the same.

In view of the above, the contempt petition stands disposed of, however, in case, the petitioner approaches the respondents to have the details of family pension, the information would be given to the petitioner within six weeks thereafter.

Rule issued against respondents is discharged.
