Special leave to appeal has been sought against the judgment of acquittal passed by the learned Additional Chief Judicial Magistrate.

The learned Magistrate has found that the allegations of the complainant are incorrect as the books were published with the consent of the applicant.

Learned counsel for the appellant although made sincere attempt, however, failed to show any perversity or substantive error in the view taken by the learned Magistrate.

In view thereof, this Court does not find any ground to grant special leave to appeal.
