Prayer in the present petition filed under Section 439 Cr.P.C. is for grant of regular bail to the petitioner in case FIR No.106 dated 20.08.2018 registered under Sections 304-B, 498-A, 34 of IPC at Police Station Mohana, District Sonipat.

Petitioner is mother-in-law. Learned counsel for the petitioner has argued that the marriage of the deceased-Mamta was solemnized with Pawan Kumar on 24.10.2016. There is no specific allegation of demand of dowry against the petitioner, but she has been roped in the case for the reason that she is mother-in-law. The co-accused (husband) and the brother-in-law are already in custody. She being lady, aged about 65 years, and there is no specific allegation against her, deserves to be admitted on bail.

Learned State counsel, on instructions from ASI Anand, states

whole family made demand of dowry, it is because of the harassment met by the deceased, she committed suicide in less than 2 years of her marriage.

I have heard learned counsel for the parties.

Considering the fact that the petitioner is a lady of 65 years of age and is in custody since 19.09.2018 and there is no specific allegation against the petitioner as regard demand of dowry, this Court deems it appropriate to admit the petitioner on bail.

Accordingly, the present petition is allowed and the petitioner is admitted on regular bail subject to his furnishing bail bonds/surety bonds to the satisfaction of trial Court.

It is made clear that the petitioner shall not extend any threat and shall not influence any prosecution witnesses in any manner directly or indirectly.
