Prayer in this petition filed under Section 439 Cr.P.C. is for grant of regular bail to the petitioner in FIR No.250 dated 15.05.2018 under Sections 376-D, 506, 120-B, 34 IPC and Section 6 of the POCSO Act, registered at Police Station Ganaur, District Sonipat.

Learned State Counsel, on instructions from ASI Vijay Pal, submits that in the present case, as many as 25 prosecution witnesses have already been examined. Thereafter, the case was fixed for defence evidence and as many as 05 opportunities have been granted, but the defence witnesses have not coming forward.

No one is present on behalf of the petitioner. Even on the earlier date also, no one was present.

Considering the fact that the petitioner himself is not leading evidence despite ample opportunities and no one has put in appearance on his behalf, the present petition is dismissed for non-prosecution.
