Petitioner has filed the instant petition seeking a Mandamus for directing the respondent authorities to renew the license pertaining to the chemist shop being run by the petitioner.

Along with the reply filed on behalf of the State is an order dated 25.7.2007 (Annexure R-1) and which has been issued by the Licensing Authority-cum-Senior Drugs Inspector, Faridabad and in terms of which the retail sale from the license of the petitioner was canceled.

Counsel representing the petitioner seeks withdrawal of the writ petition with liberty to the petitioner to avail of his remedies in accordance with law against the order dated 25.7.2007 regarding cancellation of the retail sale drug license.

As per statement made by counsel instant petition is dismissed as withdrawn with the liberty, as prayed for.

It is, however, clarified that the liberty so granted to the petitioner would not be construed as if this Court has condoned the aspect of delay, if any.
