This is a petition filed under Section 438 Cr. P.C. for grant of anticipatory bail to the petitioner in case FIR No.260, dated 06.10.2013 under Sections 419,420,467,468,471,506,120-B IPC, registered at Police Station Sultanwind, District Amritsar.

Vide Order dated 31.07.2018 notice of motion was issued in the case and the petitioner was directed to join the investigation.

State counsel being instructed by HC Manish Kumar, submits that despite interim protection granted by this Court, the petitioner has not come to join the investigation. It is further pointed out that even before filing of the present petition, the petitioner had already been declared as proclaimed offender in the year 2015. This fact has also not been disclosed in the present petition.

Confronted with this situation, learned counsel for the petitioner has also submitted that after getting interim order, the petitioner

has not even contacted him. Therefore, he is not in a position to contradict the submissions made by learned counsel for the State.

Since the petitioner was granted interim protection with a direction to join the investigation, and still she has chosen not to join the investigation, therefore, this Court does not find any ground to continue with the present petition.

Dismissed.
