Present petition has been filed under Section 482 Cr.P.C. for quashing of FIR No. 64 dated 19.04.2011, under Sections 420, 406 and 120-B of the Indian Penal Code, registered at Police Station Sadar, Fazilka and the order dated 05.01.2013 (P-2) passed by learned trial Court and all the consequential proceedings arising therefrom.

It is contended by learned counsel for the petitioner that in terms of the order dated 06.03.2019 passed by this Court, the petitioner has been granted the concession of interim bail and wishes to withdraw the present petition with liberty to take recourse to the remedy available under law.

Permitted to do so.

Dismissed as withdrawn, as prayed for.

However, it is clarified that the concession of interim bail granted by this Court vide order dated 06.03.2019 is made absolute.
