In a suit for permanent injunction, counter claim was set up by the defendants and decree for possession was granted in favour of counter-claimant/ defendant No.4 subject to deposit of court fee of ₹ 1,92,000/-/. The aforesaid court fee has already been paid by the counter-claimant. In the appeal filed by the plaintiff-petitioner, decree passed in the counter claim has also been assailed. In such an eventuality, plaintiff is liable to affix the court fee. No exception can be made out to the findings recorded in the impugned order.

This revision petition is accordingly dismissed.
