The grievance of the petitioner is that FIR No. 287 dated 14.12.2018 has been registered at Police Station Gate Hakima, District Amritsar only under Sections 323, 341 IPC, even though mother-in-law of the petitioner has died due to head injury inflicted in the said incident. Although a detailed representation dated 10.01.2019 (Annexure P-5) has been submitted but no action has been taken thereupon by the police.

Notice of motion to respondents No. 1 to 5 only.

Mr. Luvinder Sofat, AAG Punjab accepts notice on behalf of respondents. Let six four copies of the petition be supplied to him during the course of the day.

Considering the nature of the order being passed, there is no necessity to seek reply.

The petition is disposed of with direction to respondent No. 3 to objectively consider the representation dated 10.01.2019 (Annexure P-5) and to take appropriate action thereupon in accordance with law, in case it is felt necessary, within a period of eight weeks from the date of receipt of a certified copy of this order.
