This order shall dispose of COCP Nos. 651, 701 and 1218 of 2019 as issue involved is similar. The issue in the contempt petition is regarding finalization of seniority list of the Deputy Superintendent of Police.

Learned State counsel, on instructions from Mr. Arun Sekhri, IAS, Special Secretary, Home, Punjab submits that tentative seniority list has been uploaded. She produced memo No. 7/190/13-2H3/4847 dated 18.12.2019 whereby request was sent to upload tentative seniority list on the website of Punjab Police for the purpose of circulation. She contends that the persons aggrieved have been given opportunity to file objections by 09.01.2020. After receiving the objections, same would be considered and best efforts would be made to finalise the seniority list within two months

from 09.01.2020.

In view of above, the contempt petition is disposed of.

However, petitioner would be at liberty to avail remedies in accordance with law. In case statement made today is not adhered to, the petitioner would be at liberty to revive the contempt petition.
