The petitioner has preferred the instant petition under Section 439 Cr.P.C. for grant of regular bail in case FIR No.550 dated 23.09.2017, registered under Sections 498-A, 304-B, 34 IPC, at Police Station Sadar Bahadurgarh, Haryana.

Briefly stated, it is a case of the prosecution that deceased Pooja was married with petitioner Ramesh about 4 ½ years before her death. At that time, sufficient dowry was given but the petitioner and his family members were taunting her for bringing insufficient dowry and demanding more dowry. She died on 23.09.2017.

The petitioner is the husband of the deceased. Specific role has been attributed to him. Apart from it, he is responsible for the day to day happening in the house. He failed to explain the circumstances which is led

to the wife to take drastic steps. However, the trial is in progress.

As such, finding no ground to grant the benefit of regular bail to the petitioner, the instant petition stands dismissed.
