Prayer made in this writ petition under Articles 226/227 of the Constitution of India, is inter alia for issuance of a writ in the nature of certiorari for directing the respondent to set aside the illegal auction/sale conducted on 31.01.2017 for factory, land & building and plant & machinery.

2. After arguing for sometime, learned counsel for the petitioner prays for withdrawal of the present petition with liberty to the petitioner to either approach the bank or to avail the alternative remedies as are available to him, in accordance with law.

3. Dismissed as withdrawn. However, it shall be open to the petitioner to take recourse to the remedies as may be, available to him, in accordance with law.
