This is a petition that has been filed under Section 438 Cr.P.C. for grant of anticipatory bail to the petitioner in case FIR No.145 dated 08.10.2017 registered under Sections 323, 506, 498-A, 377, 506 of Indian Penal Code at Police Station Women, Ambala City.

Learned counsel for the petitioner herein would contend that the matter has been settled amicably between the parties and in terms of the said settlement a petition under Section 13-B of the Hindu Marriage Act has already been preferred and the second motion petition is now listed for 28.05.2019.

Learned counsel appearing on behalf of the complainant does not dispute this fact while also submitting that a sum of ₹ 3.5 lacs as part payment under the said settlement has also been received.

In view of the fact that the matter stands settled between the parties, the petition is allowed and interim order dated 04.04.2018 is hereby made absolute subject to the condition that the petitioner will not tamper with evidence or hamper the investigation; will not leave India without permission of the Court and will comply with the conditions contained in Section 438(2) Cr.P.C.
