The grievance of the petitioners herein is that they have been appointed as Peon/ Sewadar(a Class-IV Post) as against their entitlement to the Class-III post. The claim of the petitioners is arising out of policy dated 19.08.1999(Annexure P-1) issued by the Government of Punjab, which was/ has been framed for the “Honour and Gratitude” to the dependents of the War Heroes and Army Personnel who has attained martyrdom for the country.

Learned counsel for the petitioners argues that the case of the petitioners is squarely covered by a judgment dated 16.05.2011 rendered by this Court in CWP No. 19511 of 2008(Annexure P-12) and submits that the said judgment has since attained finality and was also implemented by the State in the case of petitioners therein. In the premise, the petitioners also submitted a representation dated 10.12.2017(Annexure P-11), which has not been adverted to by the respondents till date.

Notice of motion.

Learned Senior counsel appearing on behalf of State of Punjab, on advance service of copy of petition, has put in appearance on behalf of respondents.

Given the nature of order being passed, no further proceedings or pleadings are required.

Without commenting on the merits of the case, the writ petition is disposed of with a direction to respondents to pass a speaking order by objectively considering the contentions as raised in the representation dated 10.12.2017(Annexure P-11) along with the averments made in the instant writ petition by treating the same as supplementary representation as also the contentions raised by learned counsel for the petitioner, noted above, in accordance with law.

Let the needful be done within a period of three months from the date of receipt of certified copy of this order.
