Affidavit of Director Bureau of Investigation, Punjab, has been
filed in court today, which is taken on record. In this affidavit, it has been
stated as under:-

*“3. That it is humbly submitted that in compliance with
the abovesaid directions of this Hon'ble court, Police
File of case FIR No.32 dated 09.02.2018 under Sections
336, 379-B, 323, 148, 149 IPC and 25 Arms Act, Police
Station Sadr Zira, District Ferozepur and other relevant
records were summoned from the District Police and*

examined by the deponent with the assistance of Sh. Manmohan Kumar, PPS, Assistant Inspector General of Police, Investigation, Bureau of Investigation, Punjab.

The examination of the Police File has revealed certain lapses made during investigation of the case. Keeping in view the allegations leveled in the petition, order passed by this Hon'ble Court and lapses in the investigation conducted by the District Police, it was decided to transfer the investigation of case FIR 32 dated 09.02.2018 under Sections 336, 379-B, 323, 148, 149 IPC and 25 Arms Act, Police Station Sadar Zira to Police Station State Crime, SAS Nagar to be conducted by Assistance Inspector General of Police, State Crime Police Station, Punjab, SAS Nagar under the supervision of Inspector General of Police, State Crime, Bureau of Investigation, Punjab, SAS Nagar. A copy of the order dated 13.5.2019 regarding transfer of investigation is annexed herewith and marked as Annexure R-1.”

Keeping in view the aforesaid facts that the investigation has been transferred, the present petitions are disposed of with a direction that as and when the petitioners are required for interrogation or investigation, a written communication shall be sent at least 10 days prior to the date.

In the meantime, no coercive steps be taken against the petitioners.
