Present petition under Section 438 of the Code of Criminal Procedure is for grant of pre-arrest bail to the petitioner in Complaint No.COMA/5/2017 dated 06.12.2017 titled 'Central Bureau of Narcotics Vs. M/s Raxon Laboratories Ltd., under Section 8/22/32/38 of the Narcotic Drugs and Psychotropic Substances Act, 1985 and Rule 65(1) of the N.D.P.S. Rules, pending in the Court of learned Special Judge, NDPS, Jalandhar.

Learned counsel representing the respondent contended that the petitioner is not required to be arrested in this case and has not been arrested, rather he is required to face trial as he has been summoned by the trial Court.

In view of the above, the present petition for pre-arrest bail has become infructuous and is disposed of as such. However, the petitioner shall surrender before the Court concerned and face the trial and in case the petitioner surrenders before the trial Court and moves an application for regular bail, he shall be admitted to bail by learned trial Judge on his furnishing adequate bail bond and surety bond, after hearing the respondent-Bureau.
