FATEH DEEP SINGH, J. (Oral)

At the very onset, learned State counsel on instructions from SI Santosh Devi Police Station Women Cell, Karnal (P-1) submits that the offence under Sections 313 and 354 IPC has been deleted.

Report dated 12.03.2019 of the learned Judicial Magistrate 1st Class, Karnal has been received whereby after recording statements of respondent Shilpa and accused/petitioners-Hunny Hans, Narender Hans @ Lakhi and Neelam Rani @ Pinki, the Court has

shown its satisfaction that the compromise has been arrived at voluntarily, out of their own free will, without any undue influence, coercion or pressure.

Moreover, the private parties to this petition have put in appearance before this Court and during the course of interaction with the parties, it transpired that they have compromised the matter and resolved to end the dispute and compromised the matter as per compromise/affidavit (Annexure P-2) and shall abide by the same.

Heard.

In the light of statements made by the parties and the fact that the dispute between the parties being a pure matrimonial and the offence for which the accused have been hauled up are not of serious nature, together with the fact that compromise will go a long way in ironing out differences for betterment of future life of the parties and in view of the law laid down in '**Gian Singh Vs. State of Punjab and another**' 2012 (4) RCR (Criminal) 543 and '**Kulwinder Singh and others Vs. State of Punjab and another**' 2007 (3) RCR (Criminal) 1052, the prayer made in the petition is allowed, proceedings by way of FIR No. 41 dated 11.04.2017 registered at Police Station Women Cell, Karnal under Sections 313, 323, 34, 354, 406, 498-A and 354 IPC (out of which offences as per the stand of State offences under Sections 313 and 354 stand deleted) and all

consequences arising out of the said FIR qua the petitioners is quashed.

The petition stands allowed in those terms.
