This writ petition was filed for a declaration that the petitioner was a regular employee of the National Fertilizers Limited and seeking various service benefits relatable to that status. Perusal of the record reflects that the services of the petitioner were terminated and the same led to filing of *CWP-3826-2002*, titled **Malkiat Singh Raizada vs. national Fertilizers Limited and others**, before this Court. The said writ petition was allowed, vide order dated 4.11.2003, quashing the termination order and directing reinstatement of the petitioner in service.

Aggrieved thereby, the National Fertilizers Limited approached the Supreme Court by way of *Civil Appeal No. 467 of 2004*, titled **National Fertilizers Ltd and others vs. Malkiat Singh Raizada**. By judgment dated 12.5.2006, the Supreme Court reversed the decision of this Court and confirmed the termination order passed against the petitioner.

In the light of the aforestated developments, the cause in this writ petition may not survive for consideration on merits. That is perhaps the reason why there is no representation for the petitioner or his learned counsel when the matter is taken up for hearing.

The writ petition is accordingly dismissed for non-prosecution.
