With the able assistance of learned counsel for the State, this Court has gone through the petition.

The present petition has been filed with the following substantive prayers:-

“In view of the submissions made hereinabove, it is, therefore, respectfully prayed that the present petition may kindly be accepted and for the reasons stated hereinabove, directions may kindly be issued to respondent no.2 to take appropriate action against respondents No.4 to 9 as on account of false and frivolous complaints addressed at the instance of respondents No.4 to 9, respondent no.3 is forcing petitioner to return donation amount which has been utilized for marriage of poor and orphans by Amritsar Diocean Trust Association and police has committed serious excess in matter and, therefore, appropriate action is liable to be taken against the concerned police officials who in connivance with private respondents are pressuring innocent persons while threatening/intimidating to book them in false criminal proceedings and further prayer is

to direct respondent no.2 to provide security on account of threats as executed to him.”

Pursuant to the notice, reply by way of affidavit has been filed, wherein it has been stated that in fact an application against the petitioner has been filed by Gurmit Singh alleging that he has been duped of Rs.7.50 lacs on the pretext of migrating his son Harjot Singh to Canada.

Learned counsel for the State submits that the police has held its preliminary enquiry and found some substance in the allegations made in the complaint filed against the petitioner.

Keeping in view the aforesaid facts, the present petition is disposed of .
