Prayer in the instant petition under Section 438 Cr.P.C. is for grant of anticipatory bail to the petitioners, in case, FIR no.77, dated 11.09.2016, registered under Sections 379-B, 411 and 34 IPC, Police Station Bholath, District Kapurthala, Punjab.

The petitioners are facing trial in aforesaid FIR. On 25.01.2019, petitioners absented. Therefore, the trial court cancelling their bail bonds and surety bonds ordered for their arrest through non-bailable warrants.

Heard.

The impugned order is perfectly legal and beautifully written.

However, considering single default of the petitioner on account of his absence, his case is required to be taken up with some leniency.

The petitioners are directed to appear before the trial court within a week from today and shall be released on interim bail till conclusion of trial, subject to their furnishing fresh bail & surety bonds to the satisfaction of the trial court and undertaking that they would not be absent in future on any date. The trial court is directed to proceed against the petitioners under Section 446 Cr.P.C.
