The present petition has been filed under Section 438 Code of Criminal Procedure for grant of anticipatory bail to the petitioner in case FIR No.11 dated 20.1.2019 registered for the offences punishable under Sections 323, 354 of Indian Penal Code (Sections 325, 148, 149 IPC added later on), at Police Station Julkan, District Patiala.

Heard.

Learned counsel for the petitioner submits that a compromise has been effected between the parties and a quashing petition bearing CRM-M-20878-2019 has been filed.

Learned State counsel states that the petitioner has joined the investigation.

Without expressing any opinion on the merits of the case, this

presentation of challan, subject to the following terms:-

- (i) that the petitioner shall make himself available for interrogation as and when required by the police;
- (ii) that the petitioner shall not, directly or indirectly, make any inducement, threat or promise to any person acquainted with the facts of the accusation against him so as to dissuade him from disclosing such facts to the Court or to any police officer;
- (iii) that the petitioner shall not leave India without the prior permission of the trial Court.
- (iv) that the petitioner will seek regular bail on the presentation of challan in Court.
- (v) subject to payment of ₹ 15,000/- ordered to be paid as litigation expenses to the complainant vide order of this Court dated 2.4.2019 before the trial court on 23.5.2019.
