Present petition has been filed under Section 439 of the Code of Criminal Procedure for grant of interim bail of seven days w.e.f 21.02.2019 to 28.02.2019 to the petitioners in FIR No.378 dated 21.07.2018, under Sections 15, 16, 27-A of the Narcotic Drugs and Psychotropic Substances Act, 1985 registered at Police Station Ratia, District Fatehabad.

Learned counsel for the petitioners wishes to withdraw the instant petition qua petitioner No.1-Ranjeet Singh.

Petition is dismissed as withdrawn qua petitioner No.1.

It is contended by learned counsel for petitioner No.2 that he be granted the concession of interim bail on account of marriage of his son on 25.02.2019 at G.S. Resort, Shutrana Road, Patiala. In this regard, copy of the marriage card is annexed with the petition as Annexure P-2.

Learned State counsel has opposed the prayer for interim bail on the ground that there is apprehension, if petitioner No.2 is released on bail, there is every possibility that he will abscond and it would be very difficult to secure his presence and that will hamper the trial. Therefore, some police official may be deputed alongwith him so that he may not run away.

Heard learned counsel for the parties and perused the paper-book.

Since factum of marriage of son of petitioner No.2- Baljeet Singh is not in dispute and as such this Court deems it appropriate to release him on interim bail w.e.f. 25.02.2019 to 26.02.2019 on furnishing heavy surety bonds to the satisfaction of trial Court concerned.

Ordered accordingly.

It is directed that petitioner No.2 shall remain in company of two police officials, to be deputed by Superintendent of Police, Fatehabad and they will be responsible to produce him back. The expenses shall be borne and deposited by petitioner No.2, as per rules. Petitioner No.2 shall surrender before the Jail Authorities on 27.02.2019 at 10.00 a.m sharp.

Petition is disposed off qua petitioner No.2- Baljeet Singh in the aforesaid terms.
