The present contempt petition has been filed alleging wilful disobedience of the order dated 2.11.2018 passed by this Court in CRM-M No. 48904 of 2018. The operative part of the said order is reproduced below:

“In view of above, respondent No. 3-Senior Superintendent of Police, SAS Nagar (Mohali), is directed to look into the said representation (Annexure P-2) and decide the same expeditiously preferably within 90 days, as per law, after the receipt of certified copy of this order.

With aforesaid direction, this petition stands disposed.”

Status report by way of affidavit of Ashwini Gotyal, IPS, Assistant Superintendent of Police, City 1, SAS Nagar (Mohali) has been filed in court today. Copy thereof has been given to learned counsel for the

petitioner.

Learned counsel for the State, on instructions from SI Sudesh Chand, Police Station Phase-I, Mohali submits that the order of this court has been complied with and the representation of the petitioners has been decided. Further states that various attempts have been made to arrest the accused, thereafter accuseds have also been declared proclaimed offenders on 10.7.2019.

Learned counsel for the petitioners states that no cause of action survives in the present contempt petition. However, he seeks liberty to avail remedy available in accordance with law for redressal of the grievance, if any.

Rule is discharged.

Dismissed as infructuous with liberty as prayed for.
