The petitioner Krishna approached this Court seeking issuance of a direction to official respondents to conduct a fair and impartial investigation in FIR No.162 dated 19.5.2016 registered at Police Station Kanina, District Mahendergarh under Sections 148, 149, 323, 427 and 506 of Indian Penal Code, 1860 pertaining to injuries caused to her son Vikram, who had allegedly been given severe beatings by the accused/private respondents.

After the present petition had been filed, the police initially filed challan against two accused. Subsequently, the prosecution moved an application under Section 319 Cr.P.C., which has since been accepted and another five persons were ordered to be summoned to face trial alongwith remaining accused.

The learned State counsel, upon instructions from ASI Vijaypal, who is present in Court, has today informed that charges have since been framed and the trial is proceeding ahead.

Despite the matter having been called twice, none has put in appearance on behalf of the petitioner. It appears that the petitioner is not interested in pursuing this petition as apparently the present petition has been rendered infructuous on account of the aforestated facts.

The petition, as such, is dismissed for non-prosecution.
