This common order shall dispose of above noted two petitions as they arise out of the same FIR.

These petitions have been filed under Section 438 Cr.P.C. for grant of anticipatory bail to petitioners Sunil Kumar Joshi and Vikram Joshi in FIR No. 427 dated 13.12.2017, registered under Sections 406, 420, 34 and 506 of the IPC at Police Station Gohana Sadar, District Sonipat.

Learned senior counsel for the petitioners submits that remaining amount of Rs. 7,50,000/-, by way of a demand draft favouring the Registrar of this Court, has been got prepared and the same shall be deposited today itself. A photocopy of the said demand draft is placed on record.

Learned senior counsel for the petitioners further submits that the aforesaid amount may be disbursed to 36 persons who have arrived at a settlement before the Mediator, as per the award of the Mediator as well as the list attached with the award of the Mediator.

In view of the above, these petitions are allowed and the interim bail granted to the petitioners, vide order dated 21.03.2018, is made absolute subject to the conditions envisaged under Section 438(2) Cr.P.C.

The Registrar of this Court is directed to disburse the aforesaid amount to 36 persons as per the award of the Mediator as well as list attached with the award.

The aforesaid 36 persons will move appropriate application before the Registrar of this Court along with proof of their identity, duly attested by learned counsel representing them and thereafter, the amount

will be disbursed to them.

Criminal miscellaneous applications, if any, stand dismissed as not pressed.

A photocopy of this order be placed on the file of other connected case.
