The present contempt petition has been filed for non-compliance of the order dated 21.12.2018.

Short reply by way of affidavit of Mandeep Singh Brar, District Manager, Barnala, Punjab State Cooperative Supply & Marketing Federation, Ltd. on behalf of respondent No.4 filed in Court is taken on record. Copy given to learned counsel for the petitioners.

Learned counsel for respondent No.4 states that 220 MT paddy has already been supplied and remaining 680 MT shall be supplied within ten days from today.

In view of the same, the present contempt petition is dismissed.

Rule issued against the respondents stands discharged.

In case the needful is not done, the present contempt petition shall stand revived and the respondents shall not only liable for punishment but heavy penalty also.

Learned counsel for the petitioner has pointed out that the paddy has not been supplied as per entitlement. It was entitled for 2103 MT. If it is so, the petitioner is at liberty to avail the remedy for the balance paddy, in accordance with law.
