Petitioner Rohit has filed this petition under Section 439 of the Code of Criminal Procedure, 1973 for grant of regular bail in case FIR No.215 dated 20.09.2018, registered at Police Station Panipat Sadar, District Panipat, under Sections 302 and 452 of the Indian Penal Code.

Notice of motion was issued.

Learned State counsel appeared and contested the instant petition.

I have heard learned counsel for the petitioner as well as learned State counsel and gone through the record.

From the record, I find that the present petitioner is stated to be aged about 16 years and 3 months at the time of occurrence.

Learned counsel for the petitioner submits that all the three eye-witnesses in the present case have appeared before the trial Court and have not supported the prosecution version and have turned hostile. He has also placed on record copy of the statements of all the eye-witnesses where they

specifically stated that the accused present in the Court has not caused the injury.

The petitioner has been in custody since 21.09.2018. He is not required for any investigation or interrogation purposes as he is in judicial custody. The trial of the case may take long time. No useful purpose will be served by keeping him in custody till the final disposal of the case.

Keeping in view the facts and circumstances of the present case; without discussing the facts in minute detail and without expressing any opinion on the merits of the case, this criminal miscellaneous petition is allowed and the petitioner is ordered to be released on bail subject to his furnishing personal bonds in the sum of ₹50,000/- with one surety in the like amount to the satisfaction of the trial Court/Duty Magistrate.
