Learned counsel for the petitioner submits that despite repeated endeavors to contact the petitioners, she has not been able to establish contact with them and is, therefore, unable to address arguments on merits for lack of instructions.

In view of the aforesaid, without expressing any opinion on the merits, *suffice* to say that by sheer pendency of the writ petition over past 21 years, it does seem that either the relief sought by the petitioners has been rendered infructuous or the petitioners have otherwise lost interest in prosecuting the present petition.

Writ petition is disposed of as having been rendered infructuous with liberty to the petitioners to file appropriate application, if so advised, in case any cause of action still survives.
