The present petition has been filed under Section 439 Criminal Procedure Code for grant of regular bail to petitioner-Surinder Singh @ Sandeep Singh, in case FIR No.183 dated 13.12.2017 registered for the offences punishable under Sections 363, 366, 120-B of the Indian Penal Code, 1860 (for short 'IPC') and Section 376 IPC added later on, at Police Station Guru Harsahai, District Ferozepur.

Earlier, the prosecutrix and the petitioner got married and sought protection by filing *CRM-M-48118-2017*, which was allowed. However, the mother of the prosecutrix lodged the FIR with regard to kidnapping of her daughter and later on offence under Section 376 IPC has been added in this case. The statement of the complainant as well as prosecutrix have already been recorded.

Keeping in view the facts and circumstances of the case, without expressing any opinion on merits of the case and the fact that conclusion of trial will take considerably long time, no useful purpose

would be served by detaining the petitioner behind the bars, therefore, the present petition is allowed. Petitioner is ordered to be released on regular bail on furnishing bail bond and surety bond to the satisfaction of trial Court/Chief Judicial Magistrate/Duty Magistrate, concerned subject to following terms:-

- (a) The petitioner shall comply with the conditions mentioned in Section 437(3) Cr.P.C.
- (b) In the event of his absence on any date of hearing, the benefit of bail allowed to the petitioner shall stand withdrawn. The trial court shall be competent to cancel his bail bond and surety bond and proceed to procure his presence in accordance with law. In that eventuality the petitioner shall have to apply for bail afresh.
- (c) He shall not leave the country without the previous permission of the court.
