This petition has been filed under Section 482 Cr.P.C. for issuance of appropriate order or direction to respondent No.3 to investigate and restrain respondents No.4 and 5 to take coercive steps against the petitioner and to respondent No.3 to protect life and liberty of the petitioner.

The State has filed reply by way of an affidavit of Mr. Gurmeet Singh, PPS, DSP Raikot, District Ludhiana (Rural) on behalf of respondents No.1 to 3, which is taken on record. Replies by way of affidavits of Mr. Rajesh Sharma, Inspector SHO, P.S. Hathoor, District Ludhiana (Rural) dated 01.11.2018 and Mr. Kulwinder Singh ASI, P.S. Hathoor, District Ludhiana (Rural) dated 01.11.2018 have also been filed on behalf of respondents No.4 and 5 respectively, which are also taken on record.

It has been stated in the affidavit filed on behalf of respondents No.1 to 3 that the matter was got inquired into by the Police. After inquiry, it has been found that the petitioner had taken Banquet Hall/plot on rent for the purpose of

marriage. However, the complete dues for using that hall was not paid by the petitioner. Hence, the Police has concluded that it is purely a civil dispute, requiring no interference by the Police.

In view of the above, no further orders are required in this case.
