ANUPINDER SINGH GREWAL, J (ORAL)

The petitioners are seeking anticipatory bail in FIR No.78 dated 18.06.2017, under Sections 365, 285, 147, 148 of the Indian Penal Code ('IPC' - for short) and Sections 25, 54, 59 of the Arms Act, registered at Police Station Sector - 53, District Gurugram.

Learned counsel for the petitioners contends that the petitioners are not named in the FIR wherein it is alleged by the complainant that he has been prevented from running news agency in the name of Shankar News Agency as several persons have been obstructing his work.

A coordinate Bench of this Court, by the order dated 19.03.2018, had directed the petitioners to appear before the Arresting/Investigating Officer and join the investigation and in the event of their arrest, they were to be released on interim bail to the satisfaction of the Investigating/Arresting Officer, subject to the conditions envisaged under Section 438(2) Cr.P.C.

Learned State counsel, on instructions from SI Mahesh Kumar, states that the petitioners have joined investigation and are not required for custodial interrogation.

In view of the submissions of learned counsel for the petitioners and keeping in view the fact that the petitioners have joined investigation, the order dated 19.03.2018 granting interim bail to the petitioners is made absolute.

However, the petitioners shall abide by the conditions stipulated under Section 438(2) Cr.P.C. They shall also join investigation as and when called upon to do so.

The petition stands disposed of.
