Petitioner is seeking direction to the respondents to count the daily wage/work charge services towards qualifying service for pension keeping in view the judgment passed by Division Bench of this Court in **Harbans Lal vs. The State of Punjab and others**, CWP No.2371 of 2010, decided on 31.08.2010 (Annexure P-3).

With regard to her grievance, petitioner made a representation dated 13.08.2018 (Annexure P-2) to the Managing Director, stating therein that she was regularized in the year 1991. Her husband was regularized in the year 1991 and he expired on 08.04.2002. Thereafter, family pension was granted to the petitioner, but at the time of granting the family pension, the period during which her husband worked as daily wager has not been counted. Learned counsel for the petitioner states that the case of petitioner is squarely covered by the judgment passed in **Harbans Lal's** case (supra).

Notice of motion.

On the asking of the Court, Mr. Kiran Pal Singh, AAG,

Haryana, accepts notice on behalf of the respondent-State.

At this stage, present petition is disposed of by giving direction to respondent No.3-Chief Engineer 'OP' U.H.B.V.N., Sector-15, Panchkula to look into the representation dated 13.08.2018 (Annexure P-2) and pass appropriate order re-fixing the pay of husband of petitioner and thereafter, revise the pension in accordance with law after going through the entire record. This exercise be completed within a period of four months from the date of receipt of certified copy of this order.
