Petitioner is participating in the selection process for the post of Sub Inspector in Police Department pursuant to advertisement dated 16.04.2018 (Annexure P-1).

Due to inadvertence, in the Socio-Economic criteria, he did not mention that he was orphan. The petitioner has placed on record death certificate dated 26.06.1999 (Annexure P-3) to show that his father Shri Bhagwan had died on 20.06.1999. At that time, petitioner was 07 years of age. Hence, he is entitled to be awarded 05 marks under the Socio-Economic criteria.

Notice of motion.

On the asking of the Court, Mr. Kiran Pal Singh, AAG, Haryana, accepts notice on behalf of the respondent-State and informs that the State Government has decided to consider all the candidates for awarding marks under the Socio-Economic criteria, if, on the date of PMT and screening of documents, they produce the requisite documents.

In view of the said fact, this petition is disposed of by giving direction to the respondents to consider the death certificate dated 26.06.1999 (Annexure P-3) for awarding marks to the petitioner under the Socio-Economic criteria being orphan.
