Prayer made in the petition is for grant of regular bail to the petitioner in case FIR No.18 dated 26.1.2019 under Sections 364, 323, 324, 148, 149 IPC and Sections 325 and 326 IPC (added later on) registered at Police Station Tanda, District Hoshiarpur.

Counsel for the petitioner submits that the petitioner is a lady of 57 years of age and is the first offender. She is in custody since 26.1.2019. Counsel for the petitioner submits that the investigation of the case is complete and the challan has been presented.

Learned State counsel, assisted by counsel for the complainant, on instructions from HC Gurmit Singh and on the basis of the custody certificate, has not disputed the factual position.

Without commenting on the merits of the case, considering the fact that the petitioner is a lady of 57 years of age, she is the first offender and is in custody since 26.1.2019, this petition is allowed. The petitioner is ordered to be released on regular bail on her furnishing of bail/surety bonds to the satisfaction of the Chief Judicial Magistrate/Duty Magistrate/Illaqua Magistrate, concerned.

The petitions stands disposed of, accordingly.
