By way of filing this petition, the petitioner seeks issuance of directions to respondents No.2 to 4 to protect his life, liberty and property as he apprehends threat to the same at the hands of respondents No.5 and 6.

Learned counsel for the petitioner submits that the petitioner is an agriculturist and has been selling his agricultural produce to the commission agents, respondents No.5 and 6. It has been submitted that during the course of the dealings of the petitioner with respondents No.5 and 6, he had also taken loans and had signed certain blank documents, but now respondents No.5 and 6 are threatening to sell his land although he had never ever agreed to sell off his land.

Having heard the learned counsel for the petitioner, the petition is disposed of with a direction to Senior Superintendent of Police, District

Khanna (respondent No.2) to look into the matter and to dispose of the complaint dated 5.2.2019 (Annexure P-2) expeditiously. In case the allegations leveled therein are found to be well founded then necessary steps warranted under law be taken thereupon at the earliest.

A copy of this order along with copy of complaint Annexure P-2 be sent to the Senior Superintendent of Police, District Khanna (respondent No.2) so as to enable him to do the needful expeditiously.
