Learned counsel for the State, on instructions from Sh. Surender Kumar, Patwari, Sirsa, as well as counsel for respondent No. 4 submit that in compliance with the statement made by the counsel for respondent No. 4, compensation amounting to ₹43,197/- has been assessed which has been duly deposited with the competent authority.

Learned counsel for the petitioner, however, states that the amount of compensation is less.

Keeping in view the fact that the pipes are to be laid underground at a level 3 feet below the ground level, the compensation, as assessed by the competent authority, cannot be faulted with as the land of the petitioner remains intact.

In view of the above, this writ petition where the challenge is to

the order dated 21.01.2019 (Annexure P-8) passed by respondent No. 1 cannot be said to be illegal or calling for any interference by this Court.

The writ petition, therefore, stands disposed of with above observations.
