Petitioner Heera Lal Rawat has filed this petition under Section 439 of the Code of Criminal Procedure, 1973 for grant of regular bail in case FIR No.540 dated 10.09.2017, registered at Police Station Bhiwani Sadar, District Bhiwani, under Sections 20 and 29 of the NDPS Act, 1985.

Notice of motion was issued.

Learned State counsel appeared and contested the instant petition. Reply has been filed.

I have heard learned counsel for the petitioner as well as learned State counsel and gone through the record.

As per the prosecution version, 990 grams of charas has been recovered from the present petitioner, which falls in non-commercial quantity. The co-accused have already been granted bail by this Court.

The petitioner has been in custody since 10.09.2017. He is not required for any investigation or interrogation purposes as he is in judicial custody. The trial of the case may take long time. No useful purpose will be

served by keeping him in custody till the final disposal of the case.

Keeping in view the facts and circumstances of the present case; without discussing the facts in minute detail and without expressing any opinion on the merits of the case, this criminal miscellaneous petition is allowed and the petitioner is ordered to be released on bail subject to his furnishing personal bonds in the sum of ₹50,000/- with one surety in the like amount to the satisfaction of the trial Court/Duty Magistrate.
