Learned counsel for complainant-Ashok Kumar, has filed Vakalatnama, on his own, though he has not been impleaded as party. The same is taken on record. Office to tag the same at the appropriate place.

Through this petition under Section 439 Cr.P.C., petitioner-Manoj Kumar Jha, has prayed for grant of regular bail in case FIR No. 422 dated 18.12.2018, registered under Sections 170, 419 and 420 IPC (Section 201 IPC added later on) at Police Station Civil Lines Bhiwani, District Bhiwani.

At the outset, by placing on record, photocopy of affidavit of complainant-Ashok Kumar dated 01.01.2019, learned counsel for the petitioner submits that the matter has been compromised in between the parties. The same is taken on record. Be tagged at the appropriate place.

Learned counsel for the complainant fairly conceded that the matter has been compromised in between the parties. He has no objection, if, the instant petition is allowed and the petitioner is released on bail.

Considering overall facts and circumstances, but without expressing any opinion on the merits of the case, the petition is allowed. Consequently, petitioner-Manoj Kumar Jha, is ordered to be released on bail pending trial, on his furnishing adequate bail and surety bonds to the satisfaction of trial Court/Duty Magistrate, concerned.
