Present petition has been filed under Section 438 of the Code of Criminal Procedure (for short 'Cr.P.C.') for grant of pre arrest bail to the petitioner in case FIR No.106 dated 12.08.2018, under Section 22 of the Narcotic Drugs and Psychotropic Substances Act, 1985 (for short 'NDPS Act'), registered at Police Station Anandpur Sahib, District Rupnagar.

This Court passed the following order on 20.02.2019:-

“Contends that on account of the arrest of the petitioner in FIR No.156 dated 15.11.2018 under Section 22 of the Narcotic Drugs and Psychotropic Substances Act, 1985, registered at Police Station Kot Isse Khan, he could not appear before the learned trial Court in terms of the order dated 15.10.2018.

Notice of motion for 18.03.2019.

In the meanwhile, the petitioner is directed to appear before the learned trial Court and in case he moves an application for bail, he shall be released on interim bail till the next date of hearing on his furnishing adequate bail and surety

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*bonds to its satisfaction. The petitioner is also directed to abide
by all the conditions as envisaged under Section 438(2) Cr.P.C. ”*

Learned State counsel, on instructions from HC Naseem Khan
has acknowledged that in terms of the previous order, the petitioner has
joined the proceedings before the learned trial Court.

In view of the above, the interim order dated 20.02.2019 is
made absolute, subject to the conditions as envisaged under Section 438(2)
Cr.P.C and the present petition is disposed off.

However, it is clarified that the petitioner shall not repeat
recurrence in future and will fully cooperate with the learned trial Court
without seeking any unnecessary adjournment in the matter.
