1. Learned senior counsel states that the petitioner was appointed as Helper-Mechanic vide order Annexure P/6 dated 12.07.1995 but subsequently vide order Annexure P/7 dated 02.02.1996, status of the petitioner was changed from regular to contractual basis, whereupon the petitioner challenged the aforementioned order leading to passing of order dated 14.02.1996, staying the operation of order Annexure P/7 dated 02.02.1996. Thereafter, the petitioner was promoted from the post of Helper-Mechanic to Assistant Fitter vide order Annexure P/8 dated

15.10.2010 and from the post of Assistant Fitter to Mechanic, vide order Annexure P/9 dated 06.06.2016. Learned counsel states that in the circumstances the writ petition has become infructuous and may be disposed of as such.

2. Learned Sr. DAG states that in view of the statement of learned counsel for the petitioner, he has no objection if the writ petition is disposed of as having become infructuous.

3. In view of the statement of learned counsel for the parties, the writ petition is disposed of as having become infructuous.
