This is an application for impleadment of legal heirs of Hardayal Singh-petitioner, who is stated to have died on 6.8.2019.

For the reasons stated in the application which is duly supported by an affidavit and after hearing learned counsel for the parties, the application is allowed and the person as mentioned in para-4 of the application is ordered to be impleaded as legal heir of Hardayal Singh-petitioner. Amended memo of parties is taken on record.

However, it may be clarified that passing of this order shall not determine that widow is the only legal heir of petitioner.

Main case

Compliance report by way of affidavit of Dr. Rakesh Gupta, IAS, Director General Elementary Education, Haryana, filed today in Court is taken on record and copy supplied to counsel for the petitioner.

Learned counsel for the petitioner submits that though an amount of ₹37,441/- is due to the petitioner but the same has not been paid. He further seeks liberty to avail remedy in accordance with law for claiming interest on the delayed payment.

Learned State counsel on instructions from Mr. Gaurav Kumar, Assistant, O/o Director General Elementary Education, Haryana submits that the payment will be credited in the account of the petitioner latest by 31.12.2019.

In view of above the contempt petition is disposed of. However, the petitioner shall be at liberty to avail remedy in accordance with law for redressal of the surviving grievance.
