**Harinder Singh Sidhu, J.**

The petitioner has filed the present petition seeking extension of emergency parole to enable him to look after his mother, who is undergoing for treatment.

The petitioner has been sentenced to undergo rigorous imprisonment for 3-1/2 years in FIR No. 188 dated 11.9.2012, under Sections 148, 149, 12-B and 307 IPC and 27 of the Arms Act, registered at Police Station Cantt, Ferozepur.

The petitioner was granted parole from 03.01.2019 to 15.02.2019. He approached to the jail authorities for extension of parole by one month. However, the Jail Superintendent, Ferozepur extended the parole for nine days only i.e. from 15.02.2019 to 24.02.2019.

Notice of motion was issued on 21.02.2019 and learned State counsel was requested to verify about the medical condition of the mother of the petitioner.

Learned State counsel states that it has been got verified that the mother of the petitioner is admitted in Guru Nanak Mission Charitable Hospital, Ferozepur City for treatment of various diseases.

In view thereof, the petition is allowed. The parole period of the petitioner is extended by further three weeks commencing from 24.02.2019. He shall surrender before the Jail Authorities on expiry of extended period.
