The present petition has been filed under Section 438 Code of Criminal Procedure for grant of anticipatory bail to the petitioner in Complaint Case No. 6/2018 dated 29.01.2018 titled as '*Dr. Gobind Gupta vs. Engineer Abhijeet Bhagat and others*' under Sections 14, 14A, 18, 19, 20 and 21 of the Transplantation of Human Organs and Tissue Act, 1994, pending before the Court of Judicial Magistrate Ist Class, Sirsa.

Heard.

Learned counsel for the petitioner submits that the petitioner has appeared before the trial Court as per order dated 20.02.2019.

Learned State counsel on instructions from HC Vinod Kumar submits that the trial of petitioner is continuing and his custodial interrogation is not required.

In view of submission of learned State counsel but without expressing any opinion on the merits of the case, this petition is allowed and order dated 20.02.2019 is made absolute, subject to the following terms:-

- (i) that the petitioner shall keep on appearing before trial Court regularly;
- (ii) that the petitioner shall not, directly or indirectly, make any inducement, threat or promise to any person acquainted with the facts of the accusation against him so as to dissuade him from disclosing such facts to the Court or to any police officer;
- (iii) that the petitioner shall not leave India without the prior permission of the Court.
