Present petition under Section 482 of the Code of Criminal

Procedure has been filed with following substantive prayers:-

“It is therefore, respectfully prayed that petition filed by the petitioner may kindly be allowed and directions be issued to respondents No.1 and 2 to transfer the investigation of the case registered under Section 302/34 IPC, Police Station Sadar, Abohar, Distt. Fazilka to the Crime Branch at Chandigarh or to constitute an SIT comprising of an officer not below the rank of IPS Officer for fair and impartial investigation.

It is further prayed that any order or direction which this Hon'ble Court may deem fit and proper be also be passed in favour of the petitioner.”

On 19.07.2019, learned State counsel, after taking instructions from ASI Pawan Kumar, submitted that the Director General of Police, Punjab has marked this case for investigation to the Director, Bureau of Investigation (Crime), Punjab at Chandigarh.

Learned counsel for the State submits that some more time is required to complete the investigation.

Keeping in view the facts and circumstances of the case, the present petition is disposed of by directing the Director, Bureau of Investigation (Crime), Punjab at Chandigarh to complete the investigation positively within a period of one month from the date of receipt of copy of this order.
