1. Learned Sr. DAG states that on 20.02.2019, the stand of the petitioner was that as per OMR sheet, she secured '55' marks, whereas the last candidate called for physical screening test under General Category had secured '51' marks. Subsequently, on result of the petitioner being produced on 21.02.2019, it transpired that the petitioner had secured 41.06 marks, which was lower than the last candidate called for physical screening test.

2. Learned Sr. DAG states that on said date, the stand of the petitioner was that she had secured '51' marks, as per OMR sheet and this Court while adjourning the case for 11.04.2019, had granted opportunity to the petitioner to approach the office of respondent-Commission on 27.02.2019, whereupon the Commission was to show the petitioner her OMR sheet along with revised result. Learned Sr. DAG states that the petitioner did not appear in the office of the

Commission on 27.02.2019s or on any other date for verification of her OMR sheet and revised result.

3. Today, none has put in appearance on behalf of the petitioner despite the case having been called out twice. It appears that the petitioner is not interested in pursuing the writ petition.

4. Dismissed for want of prosecution.
